

LALIZAS Parachute Rocket ASTROS, SOLAS/MED/USCG, Red 74787

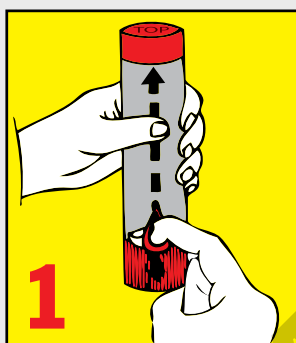
Emergency signal for position marking during rescue operations in day & night. Ejects red flare on parachute at 300 m for distress signalling and enhanced visibility.

SOLAS requires four pieces in lifeboats and liferafts, and twelve can be placed on vessel's bridge.



USE ONLY WHEN AIRCRAFT OR VESSEL IS SIGHTED

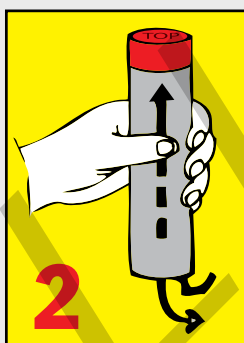
OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS



Step 1

Remove the bottom cap by pulling on the plastic ring.

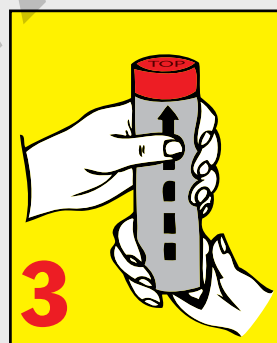
Do not remove the upper cap marked as 'TOP'.



Step 2

Release the trigger lever.

CAUTION: Stand with back to wind and point away from body when igniting.



Step 3

- Hold the parachute rocket firmly, with the arrow pointing upwards.
- Point the parachute rocket at the direction of the wind and push the trigger lever upwards with your thumb.
- **Don't fire the article if you can not control the absence of people within the safe firing distance and/or hazard zone.**
